**CIRCULAR FOR COMPETITIONS
OF OTHER TYPES OF FOOTBALL
2024/2025 SPORT SEASON**



First: Competitions Rules and Conditions

1. League Format, Match Starting List and Substitutions

2. In the event that Residents and Foreigners are not registered on the match list, the club is entitled to complete the list with citizens, Sons of UAE Women, Passport Holders and Born in UAE, in all competitions.
3. For each match in futsal or women football, three points shall be awarded for the win, one point for the draw and zero points for the loss.
4. For each match in beach soccer, three points shall be awarded for the win in normal time, two points shall be awarded for the win in extra time and one point shall be awarded for the win in penalties.
5. If two (2) or more Clubs are equal in number of points, their position in the table shall be determined according to article (21) of Competitions Regulations (for women football and futsal).
6. Substitutions made during the halftime break do not count towards the three opportunities for substitutions indicated in the table as applicable to women football.
7. Knockout Competitions
 - 7.1 UAE Cup
 - 7.1.1 The competition is mandatory for participating teams.
 - 7.1.2 The competition format shall be as per annex (1).
 - 7.2 The above table shall apply to the match starting list.
 - 7.3 Substitutions made during the halftime break do not count towards the three substitution opportunities indicated in the table as applicable to women football.
8. Minimum Number of Players to Start the Match
 - 8.1 The Match may not be started with less than the number mentioned in the below table.
 - 8.2 The number of players in the team may not decrease during the match below the number mentioned in the below table.
 - 8.3 If, during the match, the number of players decreased below the number mentioned in the below table, the referee must give the club 15 minutes to complete the number of players. If the number is not completed, the referee must end the match.

- 8.4 If a decision is taken from Disciplinary Committee on considering one of the competing clubs in futsal or beach soccer as to have lost the match, such a club shall be considered to have lost the match with a 0-7 score, unless the actual score is greater.

Second: Duration of Match

Third: Participations of Players

1	Futsal	All players registered in the club lists at UAE FA, provided they have completed 18 years of age at the time of participation.
2	Beach Soccer	
3	Women Football	All players registered in the club lists at UAE FA, provided they have completed 16 years of age at the time of participation (for Citizens) or 18 years of age (for foreigners and residents).

1. A goalkeeper from any category may take part in any competition.
2. If the goalkeeper is sent off or leaves the field of play due to an injury and all substitutions have been exhausted, the club is allowed to field any outfield player from the registered match list as a substitute goalkeeper.
3. If a club participates with two teams (A, B), players registered in team (A) competitions are not allowed to participate in team (B) competitions and vice versa. If this rule is violated, the violation shall be referred to the Disciplinary Committee and the offending club is considered to have lost the match with a 0-3 score (for women football) and a 0-7 score (for futsal and beach soccer). In addition, a fine of AED 10,000 will be imposed on the club.

Fourth: Match Organization

1. The host club is responsible for providing ambulance, security, ball kids and flag bearers for each match played in its venue, as well as the kids who escort the players to the field of play.
2. The coordinator and ball kids should be present two hours before kickoff.
3. The ball kids and flag bearers should wear a uniform that is different from the players' and referees' attires.
4. The required numbers during the match are as follows:

Fifth: Pitch Dimensions

- The matches of UAE FA competition shall be played in pitches with the following dimensions:

- Suitable rooms shall be provided for participating teams and match officials, closer to the field of play.
- The goal shall be fixed, not movable (in women football and beach soccer).

Sixth: Members of Technical, Administrative and Medical Staff Allowed to sit in Substitutes Bench

- The following numbers of members are allowed to sit on the substitutes bench, provided they are registered on the match list.

Seventh: Awards

- At the end of the season, the club that finishes in first place shall be crowned champion. The following awards are granted:

2. For cup competitions (UAE Cup + Super Cup), the number of medals mentioned in the table above will be awarded to the first and second place teams, along with a trophy for the champion.

Eighth: General Provisions

1. The Department may change the competition format if it approves the participation of a club or more.
2. The Department may change the competition format if a club withdraws prior to commencement of the competition.
3. The Department may reschedule the matches if a club withdraws after the commencement of the competition.
4. The provisions of Competitions Regulations and other relevant UAE FA regulations shall apply to any matters not provided in this circular.
5. All arising violations shall be referred to the Disciplinary Committee to take appropriate decisions.

1. Futsal

1.1 Eleven clubs will take part in this competition (Al Mooj, Shabab Al Ahli Dubai, Dibba Al Hisn, Khorfakkan, Mleeha, Al Hamriya, Al Yarmouk, Kalba, Fleetwood United, GDRFA Dubai).

1.2 UAE Futsal League

1.2.1 The competition shall be played in league format of two rounds, in the venues of clubs mentioned first.

1.2.2 The teams in the first six places of the table will qualify to playoff, as follows:



1.2.3 Matches shall be played in a home-and-away format, disregarding the goal difference. If the teams remain tied in number of wins, extra time shall be played for 10 minutes, divided into two equal halves. If the tie persists, the winner shall be determined by penalty kicks.

1.3 UAE Cup

1.3.1 As of Round of 16 until the final, the competition shall be played in home & away format in the venues of clubs mentioned first. A draw shall be conducted to distribute the clubs in the match schedule.





1.3.2 Matches shall be played in a home-and-away format, disregarding the goal difference. If the teams remain tied in number of wins, extra time shall be played for 10 minutes, divided into two equal halves. If the tie persists, the winner shall be determined by penalty kicks.

1.4 Super Cup

1.4.1 The match shall be played in neutral venue, as follows:



1.4.2 If the club that won the league is the same as UAE Cup champion, the league runners-up shall take part in the competition.

1.4.3 If the teams remain tied, extra time shall be played for 10 minutes, divided into two equal halves. If the tie persists, the winner shall be determined by penalty kicks.



2. Women Football

2.1 UAE Women League

2.1.1 The competition shall be played in two phases, as follows:

2.1.2 Phase (1): all clubs shall participate in this phase which will be played in single round-robin format in the venues of clubs mentioned first.

2.1.3 Phase (2): the teams shall be divided into two groups as per their final rankings following the end of Phase (1). This phase shall be played in league format of two rounds in the venues of clubs mentioned first.

2.2 UAE Cup

2.2.1 As of Round of 16 until the final, the competition shall be played in home & away format in the venues of clubs mentioned first. A draw shall be conducted to distribute the clubs in the match schedule.

2.2.2 In all stages of the competition, If the teams remain tied, extra time shall be played. If the tie persists, the winner shall be determined by penalty kicks.

2.3 Super Cup

2.3.1 The match shall be played in a venue to be determined by UAE FA, as follows:



2.3.2 If the club that won the league is the same as UAE Cup champion, the league runners-up shall take part in the competition.

2.3.3 If the teams remain tied, the winner shall be determined by penalty kicks.
